Senior Show Pick Up Procedures

Students in the performance are not allowed in the auditorium without a ticket and will remain backstage during the performance. If a parent has purchased a ticket for a student(s) and wish to pick them up after they have completed their dance in Act 1, they may do so during intermission in the rehearsal room located on the second floor above the backstage entrance. If your child is performing in Act 2, their designated pick up time will be at the end of the performance in the rehearsal room located on the second floor above the backstage entrance. Children performing in Act 2 will not be able to watch the performance from the audience. **Be assured that all students are well supervised by our staff and volunteers while backstage and in the rehearsal room. If you are able to volunteer at either of these performances please advise the front desk.**

Rising Star Pick Up Procedures

Students in the Rising Star performance will remain backstage for the entirety of the show. Routine #1 to #12 will be picked up in the rehearsal room on the second floor above the backstage entrance. Routine #13 to #24 will be picked up on the lower at the backstage door entrance. If your child is in more than one number, they will be picked up with their last performed dance routine. **Be assured that all students are well supervised by our staff and volunteers while backstage and in the rehearsal room.**

If you are able to volunteer at either of these performances please advise the front desk.

Please read all handouts sent home and check the information board and website (year-end show link) often for any updates and changes regarding the year end performances.
